Introduction to Instruction is a required pre-requisite for this course, it is offered as part of the Referee Instructor Course registration and begins at 2:30pm Friday.

Note: This course only needs to be completed once for ALL instructor certifications (coach, management and referee), if you have taken it previously you DO NOT need to take it again. You can check your blue sombrero account to see if you have completed this course if you aren't sure.

Some coach and referee courses will include field sessions, please bring appropriate attire. If coach or referee courses have any additional needed equipment or attire you will be notified as part of a welcome e-mail from your individual course instructor.

Internet will be available ask at check in.

What is in my linen package?

Direction to Menlo College:

From North Bay (Hwy 101)
Take 101 South to Woodside Rd. (exit 408)
Stay on Woodside Rd. until El Camino exit (South)
Stay on El Camino to Alejandra Ave (~ 1.3 mi.)
Turn right on Alejandra Ave.
Entrance to parking lot is on the left.

From North Bay (Hwy 280)
Take 280 South to Woodside Rd. (exit 25)
Turn left on Woodside and got apx 3 mi.
Turn right onto El Camino.
Stay on El Camino to Alejandra Ave. (~ 1.3 mi.)
Turn right on Alejandra.
Entrance to parking lot is on the left.

From the South Bay (Hwy 101) Take 101 North to Willow Rd (West Exit 404B) Go \sim 1.2 mi. & turn right onto Middlefield Rd. Go 0.7 mi and turn left onto Ravenswood Ave. Go \sim 0.5 to El Camino Real Turn right on El Camino and go \sim 0.7 mi. Turn right on Alejandra Ave. The parking lot is on the left.

From South Bay (Hwy 280)
Take 280 North to Sand Hill Rd. (exit 24)
Go east on Sand Hill to El Camino Real (1.3 mi.)
Turn left onto El Camino and go 1.5 mi.
Turn left on Alejandra Ave.
Entrance to parking lot is on the left

East Bay Via Dumbarton, Take the Dumbarton Bridge west After crossing the Bay, continue on along frontage road to Marsh Rd., Continue on Marsh Rd to Middlefield Rd and turn right, Go a very short distance and turn left onto Fair Oaks Ln., Go to El Camino and turn left (south), Go a short distance to Alejandra Av. And turn right. Entrance to parking lot is on the left.
